

General DPRG Competition Rules

These rules apply to **all** contests in the competition.

Rules:

- A contestant can enter up to 2 robots to compete in any competition. Additional robots can be entered for demonstration purposes; however, the robots being entered for demonstration purposes must be declared before running. Only robots declared to be competing are eligible for prizes.
- A placing robot in a contest must fulfill at least a minimum accomplishment in the contest. If the contest awards points for completion of a contest goal, a placing robot must at least achieve one point. If the contest does not award points, the robot must complete a minimum requirement stated in the contest's rules. For example, in line following to be eligible for a prize, the robot must successfully follow the course for 1/4 lap. No prizes will be awarded to a robot that just sits at the start line or appears to not be able to perform the function of the contest as decided by the judges.
- Robots that appear unsafe as decided by the judges will not be allowed to participate in the contest.
